This book contains the proceedings of an international symposium devoted to Modeling and Analysis of Defense Processes in the context of land/air warfare. It was sponsored by Panel VII (on Defense Applications of Operational Research) of NATO's Defense Research Group (DRG) and took place 27-29 July 1982 at NATO headquarters in Brussels. Except perhaps for the Theater-Level Gaming and Analysis Workshop, sponsored by the Office of United States Naval Research in 1977, this symposium was the first international scientific meeting on Operations Research/Systems Analysis in the area of land/air warfare since the conference on Modeling Land Battle Systems 2 for Military Planning sponsored by NATO's Special Programme Panel on Systems Science in 1974. That conference dealt primarily with modeling small unit (company, battalion) engagements and, to a lesser extent, large unit (corps, theater) campaigns with principal emphasis on attrition processes and movement in combat. It was considered as rather successful in that it revealed the state-of-the-art around 1972 and identified problem areas and promising approaches for future developments. With regard to foreign attendance, this workshop was largely limited to participants from the United Kingdom and the Federal Republic of Germany (see L.J. Low: Theater-Level Gaming and Analysis Workshop for Force Planning, Vol II-Summary, Discussion of Issues and Requirements for Research, SRI Report, May, 1981). It has been further developed and refined in North America and, increasingly, in Europe. The rationale behind the method is that randomized clinical trials--the "gold standard" for evidence-based medicine--are generally either not available or cannot provide evidence at a level of detail sufficient to apply to the wide range of patients seen in everyday clinical practice. Although robust scientific evidence about the benefits of many procedures is lacking, physicians must nonetheless make decisions every day about when to use them. Consequently, a method was developed that combined the best available scientific evidence with the collective judgment of experts to yield a statement regarding the appropriateness of performing a procedure at the level of patient-specific symptoms, medical history, and test

results. This manual presents step-by-step guidelines for conceptualising, designing, and carrying out a study of the appropriateness of medical or surgical procedures (for either diagnosis or treatment) using the RAND/UCLA Appropriateness Method. The manual distills the experience of many researchers in North America and Europe and presents current (as of the year 2000) thinking on the subject. Although the manual is self-contained and complete, the authors do not recommend that those unfamiliar with the RAND/UCLA Appropriateness Method independently conduct an appropriateness study; instead, they suggest "seeing one" before "doing one." To this end, contact information is provided to assist potential users of the method. This volume is intended to expand the dialogue and interest among both practitioners and academicians in a problem area worthy of attention by all. The concept of disaggregation admits to our current inability to solve many types of interrelated hierarchical problems simultaneously. It offers instead a sequential, iterative process as a workable and necessary procedure. The papers in this volume are selected from those presented at a Disaggregation Conference held in March, 1977 at The Ohio State University. We heartily applaud all those who participated in the conference and particularly appreciate the cooperation of those authors whose work is published in this collection. Part A contains four papers which define the various dimensions of disaggregation. The paper by Martin Starr, which was the text of his luncheon address at the conference, provides several interesting perspectives to the problem. Although disaggregation suggests tearing apart, as Professor Starr illustrates with his butterfly example, it also suggests a putting together or a synthesis which recognizes interrelationships and dependencies. The next paper by Lee Kra jewski and Larry Ritzman offers a general model of disaggregation for both the manufacturing and service sectors. After reading the papers in this section, as well as the papers in subsequent sections, you will identify other dimensions to hierarchical decision making which go beyond this generalized model. Republicans nominated for president a wealthy businessman and former reality show host best known on the campaign trail for his sharp rhetoric against immigration and foreign trade. Democrats nearly selected a self-described socialist who ran on a populist platform against the influence of big money in politics. While it is not surprising that Americans would channel their frustrations into votes for contenders who pledge to end business as usual, the truth is that we don't have to pin our hopes for greater participation on any one candidate. All of us have a say—if we learn, master and practice the skills of effective citizenship. One of the biggest roadblocks to participation in democracy is the perception that privileged citizens and special

interests command the levers of power and that everyday Americans can't fight City Hall. That perception is undoubtedly why a 2015 Pew Charitable Trusts survey found that 74 percent of those Americans surveyed believed that most elected officials didn't care what people like them thought. Graham and Hand intend to change that conventional wisdom by showing citizens how to flex their citizenship muscles. They describe effective citizenship skills and provide tips from civic experts. Even more importantly, they offer numerous examples of everyday Americans who have used their skills to make democracy respond. The reader will see themselves in these examples of citizens who chose to be victorious participants rather than tranquil spectators in the arena of democracy. By the end of the book, you will have new confidence that citizen participation is the lifeblood of America -- and will be ready to make governments work for you, not the other way around. This report describes the Patrol Car Allocation Model (PCAM85), a computer program to assist police agencies determine the number of patrol cars to have on duty in each geographic command at different times of the day and week; a user's guide to PCAM is included. Man schätzt, daß etwa 40% aller geschriebenen Programme in COBOL abgefaßt worden sind, wobei der Trend eher als zunehmend zu beurteilen ist. Der Grund für dieses

gesteigerte Interesse liegt vor allem in der ständig zu nehmenden Aufbereitung und Verarbeitung von Massendaten aus allen wirtschaftlich orientierten Bereichen, wofür COBOL hervorragend geeignet ist. Da die anwenderbezogenen Anforderungen an die Verarbeitung dieser Daten einer ständigen Entwicklung unterliegen, muß auch COBOL dieser Entwicklung gerecht werden. Seit 1968 hat das American National Standards Institute (ANSI), dem auch ein internationaler Beraterkreis angehört, die Standardisierung der COBOL-Entwicklung übernommen. Dadurch wurde der Grundstein für die Kompatibilität der Sprache gelegt. Heute sind alle publizierten COBOL-Versionen aufwärtskompatibel. Das heißt, daß auch Programme, die in älteren Versionen geschrieben wurden, beim Einsatz neuer Compiler-Versionen unter geringfügigen Quell-Code-Änderungen lauffähig bleiben. Damit ist COBOL zu einer lebendigen Programmiersprache geworden, die eine zukünftige Entwicklung bereits in sich trägt und universell einsetzbar ist. Da COBOL für die Verarbeitung großer Datenmengen geschaffen wurde, war ihr Einsatz in der Vergangenheit auf Großrechner beschränkt. Durch die rasche Hardware-Entwicklung, die vor allem durch immer schnellere Rechner und größere Speicherkapazitäten auf kleinstem Raum zum Ausdruck kommt, können COBOL-Programme auch zunehmend auf mittleren und Kleinanlagen eingesetzt werden. Die Computer-Hersteller haben dieser Entwicklung Rechnung getragen und eine Reihe sehr guter Compiler entwickelt, die auf dem PC einsetzbar sind.
