One objective of MFLS-2 was to reinterview as many as possible of the original 1,262 MFLS-1 respondents. Seventy-two percent of the original MFLS-1 respondents were successfully reinterviewed, providing not only information on what happened to them since 1976, but a full retrospective history that recovered events previously reported in MFLS-1. The long time span of information for those reinterviewed MFLS-1 respondents and the chance to examine issues of recall bias require linking of MFLS-2 responses to MFLS-1 responses for these women and their families. Information and suggestions on linking MFLS-1 and MFLS-2 data are thus also provided in this Guide.

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
