

How to Apply for CPD Points - English

It is possible to obtain a certificate for each module completed. To do so, each user must complete the module's quizzes with a 100% grade (you can redo the test as often as you wish). Upon meeting these criteria, a certificate of completion can be downloaded from the Tembo website.

In addition, the course has been granted a total of 34 official South African CPD points for all four modules. This is of use to South African doctors but may also have value to those in other countries, particularly in Africa. These certificates can be applied for separately for each module or in any combination of modules completed. CPD points are allocated as follows:

- Module 1: 6 points
- Module 2: 13 points
- Module 3: 4 points
- Module 4: 11 points

As the provider of the CPD certificates is the Southern African Medical Unit (SAMU) these will need to be applied for via the elearning section of the [SAMU website](#). The process is as follows:

- Download from the course website the certificate(s) for the module(s) completed.
- Download from the abovementioned section of the SAMU website and complete the short questionnaire about the course, titled "CPD 7_Evaluation_of_HPCSA_CPD".
- Email the completed evaluation form and your module certificates to samu.elearning@joburg.msf.org
- Your CPD certificate(s) will be emailed to you within a few days. If there are any delays beyond five working days, please contact Cindy at cindy.cordingley-wiid@joburg.msf.org
